<u>Transition Week:</u> Many of the children will be graduating to new fall classrooms during transition week which is August 12-16. Classroom assignments were designated in your Fall 2023-2024 Re-Enrollment Confirmation emails that were sent out in July. If you are unsure of what class your child is in for the Fall program, please stop by the front desk. Back To School Night informational packets for each class are available as of August 5th and will be sent home in your child's folder as well as emailed through Procare.

<u>Fall Fees:</u> As a reminder, the annual enrollment fee and materials fee will be billed to your Sonshine Center account in August. The fees are as follows:

Infant Center & Main Center Enrollment Fee: \$100.00 (1 per family)

Preschool Materials Fee:

\$30.00 per child in Rainbows and Sonbeams Classes \$50.00 per child in Shining Lights, Sonshine Express, Sonshine Kids, & Jr. Kindergarten classes

<u>Please Note:</u> The last day of attendance for all elementary aged children and families that are NOT enrolled for Fall 2024 is **Thursday**, **August 8th**. Faith Christian Academy and Jr. Kindergarten programs start on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>August 14th</u>, so please plan accordingly. If your child is attending Kindergarten at a local public school, we recommend you verify what the first day of school will be. There is not care available for your child at the Sonshine Center after **August 8th**.

<u>**Drills:**</u> We will be holding evacuation and tornado drills for the Main Center on Tuesday, August 7th at 10:00 am. These drills are important for both the staff and children to be familiar with what to do in case of emergency. The drills will take approximately 20 minutes and will be out of the classroom area during this time, so please plan accordingly.

FCA 1st Day of School: The K-8 Faith Christian Academy students will be returning on Wednesday, August 17th for the first day of school! This will affect traffic patterns and parking for Sonshine Center. A map is attached to show how traffic will be guided and where it is safe to park to enter the Center. When FCA school is in session there will be NO PARKING permitted on the south east side of the building. Please also note that the busy times will be at the start and end of the FCA school day which are 7:45-8:10 am and 2:30-3:10 pm. Remember, the traffic pattern and parking designations are in place to ensure safety for all children so please cooperate, be kind and respectful to the volunteers that are helping direct traffic!
